Where can you find a copyeditor who can edit that manuscript with excerpts in French? And what about that other manuscript on your schedule, on knitting patterns? And the next one, about home repair? And that upcoming multi-author project on advances in psychology? You can't give projects like those to just any freelancer.

Here are some handy places for tracking down just the right copyeditor:

- ♣ **The Editorial Freelancers Association (EFA) member directory:** The directory is searchable by location, freelancer surname, and freelance specialty. Go to <http://66.241.221.102/EFADirectory/select.asp>.
- ♣ **The EFA JobList:** This job board allows publishers and others who need a freelancer to post a description of a project, at no charge. Only EFA members who subscribe to the JobList see posts to it. Go to <http://www.the-efa.org/forms/jobphoneform.html>.
- ♣ **The Copyediting-L Freelancers List:** Copyediting-L is an e-mail list with subscribers from around the world. One subscriber maintains a page with information on list members' specialties. Go to <http://ce-l.technology-corner.com/freelance.html>.

These sources can also help you find other types of freelancers, such as graphic artists, desktop publishers, designers, and proofreaders.
